

STUDY OF ACHIEVEMENT MOTIVATION AMONG TRIBAL AND NON TRIBAL

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Year of study : 2000

OBJECTIVES

To find out whether there exists any significant difference in achievement motivation among Tribal and non tribal pupils (total sample and subsamples based on sex)

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey method

Sample : 530 IX standard students drawn by using stratified random sampling technique.

Tool : Scale of achievement motivation, General data sheet

Statistical Techniques: Two tailed test of significance of difference between mean scores of large independent samples.

RESULT

There is no significant significant difference in achievement motivation among Tribal and non tribal pupils
