

INTERACTION EFFECT OF GENDER MARITAL STATUS AND TEACHING  
EXPERIENCE ON OCCUPATIONAL MENTAL HEALTH OF SECONDARY SCHOOL  
TEACHERS OF KERALA

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### **OBJECTIVES**

To find out whether gender, marital status and teaching experience have significant main and interaction effects on occupational mental health.

### **METHODOLOGY**

**Method used** : Survey

**Sample** : 500 teachers of high school section from different schools of kozhikkode, malappuram, Ernakulam, Alappuzha , Pathanamthitta, Kollam and Thiruvananthapuram revenue districts.

**Tool** : Genral data sheet ,Occupatioanal mental health scale

**Statistical Techniques** : Three way analysis of variance with 2 x 2x 2 factorial design

### **RESULT**

The comparison of mean scores revealed that male teachers have less negative job carry over than female teachers are more satisfied with the profession when compared to male teachers. But there is no significant effect of gender on occupational mental health.
