RESULT

The study revealed parents of a Malppuram district have only moderate attitude towards girls higher education. It is also found that the attitude towards girls higher education among. Muslim parents is lower than that of Hindus and Christians and the attitude of low SES group is less than that of high and average SES groups. The study revealed parents from small families have higher attitude than that of large families and parents from forward community have higher attitude than that of scheduled community parentrs followed by backward community parents.
