OBJECTIVES

- To find out the effect of Gender and Faculty on Altruism and Emotional Intelligence of student teachers.

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey Method.

Sample : study conducted on a sample of 650 student teachers under the University of Calicut.

Tool : Altruism Assessment scale, Emotional Intelligence Scale.

Statistical Techniques : Pearsons product moment coefficient of correlation (r) , 't' test for large independent sample, ANOVA.

RESULT

significant relationship was found between the variables Altruism and Emotional intelligence of total sample and total of subsamples based on gender and faculty,
