OBJECTIVES

- To find out the extent of Occupational Stress of teacher educators in the total sample and the relevant subsample.
- To find out whether there exists significant difference in the occupational Stress of teacher educators between relevant subsamples.

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey method

Sample : 200 teacher educators working in B.Ed colleges of Malabar area.

Tool : Occupational Stress Scale

Statistical Techniques : t-test, ANOVA

RESULT

Results shows that Mean scores of Occupational stress obtained for the total sample is 144.96. Female teachers and teachers from unaided school experience more occupational stress. Interaction effect of Type of Management and Locale of Institution do not have significant main effect on Occupational Stress of teacher educator.
