

PERCEIVED COMFORT OF HOME ENVIRONMENT AND OCCUPATIONAL ROLE
PERFORMANCE OF SCHOOL TEACHERS

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OBJECTIVES

- To find out if there exist any significant relationship between perceived comfort of home environment and occupational role performance of school teachers.
- To find out if there exist any significant relationship between perceived comfort of home environment and occupational role performance of school teacher based on gender, level of education, years of service

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey method

Sample : 400 school teachers in Kerala

Tool : Scale of perceived comfort of home environment, Occupational role performance assessment scale (Mukthar & Sreekumar 2014)

Statistical techniques : Preliminary analysis, Correlation analysis, Test of significance of difference between means, Anova

RESULT

There exist significant relationship between perceived comfort of home environment and occupational role performance of school teachers. The main and interaction effect of gender, level of education, and perceived comfort of home environment on occupational role performance of school teachers is moderate.
