

## SOCIAL COMMITMENT OF B.ED. STUDENTS

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Year of study : 2010

### **OBJECTIVES**

- To find out the extent of Social Commitment of B.Ed students in the total sample and relevant subsample based on gender, locale of institutions and type of management of institutions.
- To compare the Social Commitment of B.Ed students in the relevant subsamples based on gender.
- To compare the Social Commitment of B.Ed students in the relevant subsamples based on locale of institutions.
- To compare the Social Commitment of B.Ed students in the relevant sub samples based on type of management of institutions.

### **METHODOLOGY**

**Method used** : Survey method

**Sample** : 602 B.Ed students from various Teacher Training Colleges in Calicut University

**Tool** : Social Commitment Scale(Faooque & Jamseer 2010)

**Statistical Techniques:**Test of significant difference between means for large independent sample, ANOVA (one-way)

### **RESULT:**

Social Commitment among B. Ed students do not differ significantly irrespective of their gender and locale of institution. Significant difference is found in the mean scores of Social Commitment of B.Ed students based on type of management of institutions. The mean value of unaided B.Ed students occupies first position followed by Aided and Government B.Ed students.
