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OBJECTIVES

- To find out the extent of internet use among higher secondary school students and teachers for the total sample
- To find out the extent of internet use among higher secondary school students and teachers for the sub sample based on gender and locale

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey method

Sample : 750 higher secondary school students and 300 teachers in Malappuram district

Tool : Questionnaire on the use of internet among higher secondary school students (Saleem & Sabna, 2010), Questionnaire on the use of internet among higher secondary school teachers (Saleem & Sabna, 2010).

Statistical techniques : Percentage analysis

RESULT

Out of 750 higher secondary school students only 16.13% of students are high internet users. Majority of the students are moderate users. 17.33% of students are low users. There exists significance difference in the use of internet between the higher secondary school students when they are classified on the basis of gender and locale. There exists significance difference in the use of internet between the higher secondary school teachers when they are classified on the basis of gender.
