

DISTRIBUTION OF PATTERN OF SOCIO ECONOMIC STATUS, INTELLIGENCE AND SCHOOL  
IMAGE OF CENTRAL GOVERNMENT STATE GOVERNMENT AIDED AND UNAIDED  
SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS OF CALICUT DISTRICT

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**OBJECTIVES**

- To find out whether there is significant difference in the socio economic status and intelligence of secondary school students of central government, state government, aided and unaided secondary school students of Calicut district
- To find out whether there is significant difference in the school image of secondary school students of central government, state government ,aided and unaided secondary school students of Calicut district

**METHODOLOGY**

**Method used** : survey method.

**Sample** : 628 students. (Government 204 aided 237 unaided 134 central government 53)

**Tool** : Scale for school image, Socio economic status scale, Verbal group test of intelligence

**Statistical techniques:** Preliminary analysis Percentage analysis Test of significance of difference between means 2x3x3 anova, Scheffes test for multiple comparisons

**RESULT**

There is significant difference in the socio economic status and intelligence of students of central government ,state government aided and unaided schools of Calicut districts There is significant difference in school image of students of, state government aided and unaided schools at 0.05 level.
