FAMILY STRESS AND STUDENTS EMPOWERING COMPETENCY OF FEMALE TEACHERS

OBJECTIVES

To find out if there exists any significant relationship between family stress and student empowering competency of female teachers.

METHODOLOGY

Method: Survey Method

Sample: 370 female teachers from Malapurram and Calicut districts of Kerala.

Tool: Family Stress Inventory, Student Empowering Competency and Assessment Scale.

Statistical techniques: Pearson's Product Moment Coefficient of correlation, Test of significant differences between Mean for different categories- 't'test for large independent and Analysis of Variance

RESULT

The result shows that there exists negligible relationship between family stress and student empowering competency of female teachers.
