RESULT

The result of the study shows that the major psycho-social problem of adolescents is mainly accumulated in the educational and emotional areas. Problems are comparatively less from the social problem area. Problems like anxiety short temperedness academies under achievements, strict rules of school, over expectations of parents have high percentage of occurrence among adolescents at higher secondary level. The result of the study reveals that, in the subsample based on gender and type of management of institution there is significant difference in the extent of educational and behavioural problem area.
