METHODOLGOY

Sample : 809 higher secondary school students

Tool : Scale of commitment to democratic values

Statistical Technique: Preliminary analysis using the mean, median, mode standard deviation, skewness, kurtosis & percentiles, Test of significance of difference between means for large samples. One way ANOVA

RESULT

In gender wise boys have higher commitment to democratic values than the girls. Commitment to democratic value is higher in students of urban than rural. In type of management, commitment to democratic values is higher in the unaided school students greater than the Govt, Aided and CBSE. In the subject of specification the commitment to democratic values are more in the science students than the humanities and commerce.
