Statistical techniques : Percentage analysis, ANOVA.

RESULT

The percentage analysis of the component wise post materialistic values shows that there is significant difference seen in the post materialistic values of prospective women teachers in Kerala. The level of significance of post materialistic values based on the subject of specialization shows that there is no significant difference seen in the post materialistic values of secondary level women prospective teachers in Kerala based on the subject of specialization
