OBJECTIVES

- To find out the extent of social reticence among higher secondary school students
- To find out the influence of parenting styles on social reticence of higher secondary school students in the total group and sub group based on gender

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey method

Sample : Six hundred higher secondary school students

Tool : Social reticence scale(Munthas and Shyni 2014), Scale of parenting style (Gafoor and Abidha 2012)

Statistical techniques : Percentage Analysis, one way ANOVA, Test of significance of difference between means

RESULT

Students with neglectful parenting style are more socially reticent than the student with other parenting style. The effect of parenting style on social reticence of higher secondary school students vary by gender
