- To find out whether there exist any significant relationship between Perceived Dimensional Means-End Capacity and Perceived Social Acceptance of student teachers for the sub sample and for the total sample

METHODOLOGY

Method : Survey method
Sample : student teachers in Kerala
Tool : Perceived Dimensional Means-End Capacity Assessment Scale and Perceived Social Acceptance Inventory.

Statistical Techniques : Test of significance of the difference between means, Three way ANOVA : $2 \times 2 \times 2$ factorial design, Pearson's product moment of correlation.

RESULT

There exists low significant relationship between Perceived Dimensional Means-End Capacity and Perceived Social Acceptance of student teachers.
