OBJECTIVES

To find out the extant of relationship between creativity (and its sub components- fluency, flexibility and originality) and achievement in Malayalam.

> To test whether significant difference exists in creativity between high-average and low achievers in Malayalam.

METHODOLOGY

Method used : Survey method

Sample : 500 secondary school pupils.

Tool: Generalized achievement test in Malayalam for secondary classes., A comprehensive test of creativity (sumangala, 1988)

Statistical Techniques : One-way analysis of variance, Two- tailed test of significant of difference between mean score for large independent samples, Pearson's product moment co-efficient of correlation, Test of significant of "r", 0.99 confidence interval of "r", Shared variance $r^2 \times 100$.

RESULT

The study reveals that significant difference exist in creativity between High Average and Low Achievers in Malayalam. Also reveals that creativity has significant relation with Malayalam achievement.
